To ensure a neutral and inclusive environment for all participants, political candidates or those currently in office are asked to adhere to the following guidelines while attending West Seneca Youth & Recreation events and activities:

- 1. Identification: A sign and/or name tag displaying your name and the position you hold or are a candidate for is permitted.
- 1. Attire: Shirts or other clothing items that promote a specific political candidate or party are not allowed.
- 2. Distribution of Materials: Distributing any political materials, such as flyers or pamphlets focusing on goals, accomplishments, etc., is prohibited.
 - 4. Political Discussion: While we understand that political discussions may arise naturally, we ask that you refrain from engaging in such conversations as much as possible, especially in situations where it might impact the enjoyment or participation of others.

By following these guidelines, we can maintain a neutral atmosphere that is conducive to everyone's enjoyment and participation.
