Park Rules

- Parks are open from dawn until dusk.
- No alcohol of any kind is permitted in any park.
- Park shelters at Veterans Park, West Seneca Soccer Complex, Fireman's Park and the Kiwanis Pavilion can be reserved. All other park shelters are first come, first served.
- All Town of West Seneca local laws and rules posted at the park must be followed.
- To reserve any other Town of West Seneca Facility such as a Baseball/Softball Diamond, Ice Rink, Soccer Field etc. please call (716) 674-6086 for more information.

Pavilion Rules

- Protective coverings must be used on all tables for events involving food, arts/crafts, and any other messy material. Table coverings must be provided by the renting organization/person. All pavilions must be returned to pre-event condition. A fee of \$50 will be assessed for housekeeping for facilities not left in pre-event condition.
- Trash receptacles will be made available; extra liners will be in the bottoms of the receptacles.
- No inflatables, grills, etc. are permitted in addition to your pavilion usage approval. Tents are permitted.
- Town of West Seneca parks are a tobacco-free zone. Alcohol is not permitted without special permission from the Town under a separate agreement. (See Chapter 27 of the West Seneca Town Code.)
- Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by 2 adults, at all times.
- The conduct of all individuals attending the event is the responsibility of the renting party. Each attendee must be in strict compliance with Town of West Seneca ordinances and State and County laws. Any individual that does not comply will be asked to leave.
- Groups should not arrive any more than 10 minutes before their stated "start" time. Groups are expected to conclude activities by the stated "end" time on their permit. Any cleanup should take place prior to the "end" time.
- Property damage should be reported to the Recreation Department immediately. The Town will assess a fee for the cost to repair any damage to the facility caused by the rental party. The Town of West Seneca is not responsible for theft of items left unattended. All valuables, including those on display (such as artwork, etc.), are the sole responsibility of the owner. The rental organization/person must ensure that everyone adheres to all current guidelines and rules made by the Centers for Disease

Control and Prevention (CDC), New York State Department of Health, Erie County Department of Health, and Town of West Seneca, if applicable.
